

# Grace Homeschool PSP

(School enrollment for students of homeschooling families)

- Christian Private School Satellite - Files as a private school with the State of California – Parents are homeschool teachers
- Yearly Enrollment Fee
- Monthly School Tuition
- Discount if Tuition paid in full
- PSP Holds Students' Cumulative File
- Parent one-on-one meetings and support as needed
- You set your own school calendar to fit your family's needs and fit any co-op classes
- Curriculum Guidance
- Lesson Planning Guidance
- Design High School 4-Year Plan
- Provide High School Transcripts
- (SEP) Student Education Plan (same as IEP) for students who need adjustments to their education plan
- Graduation/Promotion Ceremonies and certificates
- Quarterly Monthly Meetings
- Mandatory Paperwork Meetings - K-8th parent meets quarterly, HS parents meet each semester, and see website for more information on special meetings
- HS Students guidance meetings for students
- New families to Grace PSP get discounted registration fee when registering for Grace Classes for the first time
- Faith Deposit collected at enrollment covers any fees charged for late paperwork, late payments, etc.

# Grace Homeschool Classes

(Grace Classes are **NOT your school** but outside-of-the-home academic and enrichment classes to aid Christian homeschooling families)

- Registration is per semester – Pay registration fee each semester
- Fees for each class are charged per semester
- Payment options & Pay in Full and other discounts available
- Classes meet weekly on church campus – Tuesdays & Thursdays for Jr High & High School and Wednesdays for K-8<sup>th</sup>
- Small class sizes
- Class times range from 1~2 hours per week – Attend in class time and also homework done at home for most classes
- PK classes are offered for younger siblings of registered K-12 students
- Choose to take one or several classes – Parents decide
- Paid Tutors plan and lead classes for Grades K-12, family given course description and weekly syllabus
- Curriculum chosen by tutor for the class (not included)
- Homework assigned by Tutor per the weekly syllabus
- For Graded Classes - Grades are generated and progress reports sent to parent every 4 weeks and final grade for your own report card
- Socialization and great way to connect with other homeschooling families
- Lunch time with friends and other homeschool families – Offer monthly hot lunches; have snacks for sale
- Follows the Grace Homeschool Classes school year calendar – Weekly Activities Calendar
- Discounts towards class fees available by helping extra on campus beyond which parent is required
- Classes Memory/Yearbook available for purchase
